Vendor Fees

Vendors who reserve a space **prior to April 1**, may do so for **§25.00** (after April 1, the cost will be \$35.00). Due to the number of vendors competing for spaces, we are encouraging you to send your application early. Submission of your application does **NOT** guarantee your acceptance into the festival.

We ask that you please follow these rules:

Vendors may set up any time after 9:00 am on April 17. <u>All vehicles must be moved to the designated vendor parking area by 11:00 am</u>.

At the conclusion of the festival, all vehicles must be out of the vending area by 5:00 pm on April 17.

The festival will **NOT** be cancelled for bad weather. There are no refunds due to weather.

Vendors that are **NOT** on site by 11:00 am will **NOT** be allowed to set up and refunds will **NOT** be provided.

Priority is given to repeat vendors who have a positive relationship with the festival.

Each rented space is approx. 15 ft x 15 ft. You may rent more than one space. The festival reserves the right to site and assign spaces to all vendors.

Booths will be set up on pavement. Each vendor must provide his or her own tent, table, chair(s), and electrical drop cord (if power is required.) Specify if you need assistance with set up. Due to the location of the festival, a tent is recommended.

Limited electrical and water hookups are available upon request.

To help our vendors be successful the Festival Committee tries hard to prevent duplication of products sold by our vendors. To meet this goal we ask that you be <u>specific</u> in the type of product that you will be selling. You are required to notify the committee if the type of vending changes from your initial application or discussion with a member of the committee. The Festival Committee reserves the right to reject any changes if approval has already been granted for that same type of product with another vendor (food, crafts, etc.).

Each vendor is responsible for the security of his or her concession booth, merchandise and vehicles. Officers from the Pickens County Sherriff's office will patrol the area occasionally; however, security is your responsibility.

The Festival Committee reserves the right to reject any controversial vending. Alcohol and yard sales will **NOT** be permitted.

You are responsible for collecting and reporting South Carolina sales tax.

Violation of these rules may result in removal from the festival and denial of future participation in this event.
